Ministry Background:

Kehra is 30 minutes east of the capital of Tallinn. For over 100 years, there has been a small body of believers in this Estonian factory town, meeting first under the Tsar, then under both Nazi and communist governments. For many years they met in a small wooden church, with no running water or heat, located on the outskirts of town.

After the fall of communism in the early 1990's, this small group of believers was able to purchase a large office complex from the government. The building was originally built to house the local farmers' cooperative. It is located in the center of town, on the major walking path, across the street from the post office. The new facility provided room for growth, as well as a "visual" statement to the community.

For the past ten years, they have seen steady growth, with an outreach to the city through clothing distribution, sports, and children's clubs. They have purchased the property primarily with their own funding, but need help from the outside with the remodeling.



Description of Work:

The church members have been renovating the building, one wing at a time. Most of the Sunday School wing is finished, and the new sanctuary, as well as the parsonage. The dorm and office area, with new bathrooms, is the next phase of the project
